Explain context (speaker, audience, pronoun antecedents, and situation) and analyze the significance of the passage to Genesis as a whole, including plot elements, conflict, symbolism, characterization, theme, and other literary elements / devices.

1. "God saw everything that he had made, and indeed, it was very good."
2. "They heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden as the time of the evening breeze, and the man and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden."
3. "My punishment is greater than I can bear! Today you have driven me away from the soil, and I shall be hidden from your face; I shall be a fugitive and a wanderer on the earth, and anyone who meets me may kill me."
4. "And when the LORD smelled the pleasing odor, the LORD said in his heart, 'I will never again curse the ground because of humankind, for the inclination of the human heart is evil from youth; nor will I ever again destroy every living creature as I have done.'"
5. "Look, they are one people, and they have all one language; and this is only the beginning of what they will do; nothing that they propose to do will now be impossible for them. Come, let us go down, and confuse their language there, so that they will not understand one another's speech."
6. "I know well that you are a woman beautiful in appearance; and when the Egyptians see you, they will say, 'This is his wife'; then they will kill me, but they will let you live. Say you are my sister, so that it may go well with me because of you, and that my life may be spared on your account."
7. "I have sworn to the LORD, god Most High, maker of heaven and earth, that I would not take a thread or a sandal-thong or anything that is yours, so that you might not say, 'I have made ___ rich.'"
8. "Know this for certain, that your offspring shall be aliens in a land that is not theirs, and shall be slaves there, and they shall be oppressed for four hundred years; but I will bring judgment on the nation that they serve, and afterward they shall come out with great possessions."
9. "Will you indeed sweep away the righteous with the wicked? Suppose there are fifty righteous within the city; will you then sweep away the place and not forgive it for the fifty righteous who are in it? Far be it from you to do such a thing, to slay the righteous with the wicked! Far be that from you! Shall not the Judge of all the earth do what is just?"
10. "I beg you my brothers, do not act so wickedly. Look, I have two daughters who have not known a man; let me bring them out to you, and do to them as you please; only do nothing to these men, for they have come under the shelter of my roof."

11. "“Lord, will you destroy an innocent people? Did he not himself say to me, “She is my sister”? And she herself said, “He is my brother.” I did this in the integrity of my heart and the innocence of my hands.’ Then God said to him in the dream, ‘Yes, I know that you did this in the integrity of your heart; furthermore it was I who kept you from sinning against me.’”
12. "“The fire and the wood are here, but where is the lamb for a burnt offering?’ ___ said, ‘God himself will provide the lamb for a burnt offering my son.’ ... ‘Do not lay your hand on the boy or do anything to him; for know I know that you fear God, since you have not withheld your son, your only son, from me.’”
13. "“Put your hand under my thigh and I will make you swear by the LORD, the God of heaven and earth, that you will not get a wife for my son from the daughters of the Canaanites, among whom I live, but will go to my country and to my kindred and get a wife for my son ___.”
14. "“Two nations are in your womb, and two peoples born of you shall be divided; the one shall be stronger than the other, the elder shall serve the youngest.”
15. "“Your brother came deceitfully, and he has taken away your blessing.’ ___ said, ‘Is he not rightly named ___? For he has supplanted me these two times. He took away my birthright; and look, now he has taken away my blessing.’”
16. "“And he dreamed that there was a ladder set up on the earth, the top of it reaching to heaven; and the angels of God were ascending and descending on it. And the LORD stood beside him and said, ‘I am the LORD, the God of ___ your father and the God of ___; the land on which you lie I will give to you and to your offspring....’”
17. "“What is this you have done to me? Did I not serve with you for ___? Why have you deceived me?’ ... ‘This is not done in our country—giving the younger before the firstborn. Complete the week of this one, and we will give you the other also in return for serving me another seven years.’”
18. "“Is it a small matter that you have taken away my husband? Would you take away my son’s mandrakes also?’ ___ said, ‘Then he may lie with you tonight for your son’s mandrakes.’”
19. "“You shall not give me anything; if you will do this for me, I will again feed your flock and keep it: let me pass through all your flock today, removing from it every speckled and spotted sheep and every black lamb, and the spotted and speckled among the goats; and such shall be my wages.”
20. "“And she said to her father, ‘Let not my lord be angry that I cannot rise before you, for the way of women is upon me.’ So he searched, but did not find the household gods.”

21. "You shall no longer be called ___ but ___, for you have striven with God and with humans, and have prevailed."
22. "When ___ . . . saw her, he seized her and lay with her by force. And his soul was drawn to ___, daughter of ___, he loved the girl, and spoke tenderly to her"?"
23. "But when his brothers saw that their father loved him more than all his brothers, they hated him, and could not speak peaceably to him."
24. "This we have found; see now whether it is your son's robe or not.' He recognized it, and said, 'It is my son's robe! A wild animal has devoured him.'"
25. "As she was being brought out, she send word to her father-in-law, 'It was the owner of these who made me pregnant.' And she said, 'Take note, please, whose these are, the signet and the cord and the staff.' Then ___ acknowledged them and said, 'She is more in the right than I, since I did not give her to my son Shelah.'"
26. "It is not I; God will give Pharaoh a favorable answer."
27. "Do this and you will live, for I fear God: if you are honest men, let one of your brothers stay here where you are imprisoned. The rest of you shall go and carry grain for the famine of your households, and bring your youngest brother to me."
28. "Alas, we are paying the penalty for what we did to our brother; we saw his anguish when he pleaded with us, but we would not listen. That is why this anguish has come upon us."
29. "Go, follow after the men, and when you overtake them, say to them, "Why have you returned evil for good? Why have you stolen my silver cup? Is it not from this that my lord drinks? Does he not indeed use it for divination? You have done wrong in this.'"
30. "Now, therefore, please let your servant remain as a slave to my lord in place of the boy; and let the boy go back with his brothers. For how can I go back to my father if the boy is not with me? I fear to see the suffering that would come upon my father."
31. "God sent me before you to preserve for you a remnant on earth, and to keep alive for you many survivors. So it was not you who sent me here, but God; he has made me a father to Pharaoh, and lord of all his house and ruler over all the land of Egypt."
32. "Not so my father! Since this one is the firstborn, put your right hand on his head.' But his father refused, and said, 'I know, my son, I know; he also shall become a people, and he also shall be great. Nevertheless his younger brother shall be greater than he.'"
